NEW BUSINESS

- **2012 National Square Dance Convention.** (Roy and Janet Beilcoff, Asst. General Chairman and Scott/Kathy Donmoyer – 61st National Square Dance Convention)

Janet Bellcoff, Asst. General Chairman of the 61st National Square Dance Convention, gave a presentation regarding the National Square Dance Convention in Spokane, Washington. The Washington Federation submitted a bid in 2006 and was approved for the 2012 convention. Janet informed us that National Conventions are held in a Western State only 25% of the time, so this convention will be a wonderful opportunity to be involved in a National Convention close to home.

Janet stressed the importance of registering early for this convention. Please go to <http://www.61nsdc.com/> to complete the registration form and to find a volunteer form. Just like dancers from Washington volunteered to help the Oregon National Convention in 2005, dancers from Oregon are being asked to volunteer 2 hours of their time. There are several callers/cuers in our area that have committees that need volunteers. The group was reminded that the best way to support the National Convention is to buy a ribbon.

Kathy Donmoyer spoke about the six Hospitality Rooms that will be made available for workers and key personnel (VIP/International Room, Worker Room, Entertainment Room, Vendor Room, a Youth Room, and a RV Park Hospitality Area). Although the Convention budgets money for coffee and water, they do not have enough money for extra snacks for these hospitality rooms. So some groups plan raffles and other fund-raising events to assist the Hospitality Rooms. Kathy indicated that \$3000.00 has been given to the Youth Hospitality Room and David Krause indicated that \$600.00 has already been raised for the Vendor Hospitality Room, that he is responsible for.

- **Reconsider Policy of Requiring Non-dancing Partners To Pay Admission Fees.** (Mary T. Withers)

TVC wrote and read a letter to the Executive Chairs of the National Convention, requesting that they reconsider the policy of requiring non-dancing partners to pay admission fees. Janet Bellcoff replied that the National Convention Committee is already looking into this issue and trying to figure out a way to make this happen, without having people abuse the system. Janet further said that this policy also impacts parents and youth.
