# **OLD BUSINESS**

# TVC Club/s Host A State Meeting in September of 2013: Debra Welch

According to the Rotation Chart in the Oregon Federation's Practices and Procedures document, the Tualatin Valley Council is scheduled to host the September 2013 State Meeting. The State Executive Board meetings are to be held in accordance with the Or Fed By-Laws, Article 6.

A State Meeting can bring in an additional 50+ people to a dance, adding revenue to the club. Before making a decision, the *Oregon Federation's Practices and Procedures* document provides the following information regarding Hosting a State Meeting:

- 1. Avoid 5<sup>th</sup> Friday/Saturday weekends
- 2. Saturday: Host provides 2 meeting rooms for the Officers Meeting and the Delegates Meeting. The host Area Delegate serves as Chairperson of the Delegates Meeting. The meetings are approximately 2 hours in length.
- 3. Host club provides a dinner before the Saturday dance. This dinner may be a potluck. Hosts may ask for a \$2.00/person donation to defray the cost and/or put out a "kitty".
- 4. Saturday Night Dance (Introduce State Officers)
- 5. Sunday: General Meeting from 9:00 1:00. Tables must seat 37 and an additional Seating Area for 75 people. Coffee break at 11:30 with the host providing a snack.
- 6. Host provides a sound system.
- 7. Host places an Ad in the OFN by the first of the month, 2 months before the meeting.

# **Motion.** A motion was made: **TVC should host the State Meeting/Dance in Sept of 2013.** A discussion followed:

- It was recommended that the motion be amended to allow a TVC Club to host the meeting, rather than TVC, since clubs typically host State meetings. The reasoning behind this suggestion was: if a TVC dance occurs on the same night as a Club dance, the club will not want to go dark to attend the TVC dance. It was further suggested that it is much easier for a club/s to be responsible rather than the TVC board members.
- Sally and Mike Duyck offered to be in charge of the State Meeting, providing a club could be the host.
- The motion passed.
- Discuss with your club members if your club would be willing to provide the venue. Since TVC is the host, TVC will select the caller and cuer as well as pay for the cost of the dance.
