I have received a request for the TVC to sponsor a more advanced dance for our advanced dancers. On June 30, 2018, we can either have another Round Dance, or a dance with more advanced level dancing. If we chose the second option, we could start the dance with an hour and a half mainstream dancing, with easy level rounds. The second 1 ½

hours would be a plus dance with rounds to level 4. At the end of the mainstream portion, there could be an introduction to plus with the first dance in the second part of the dance an easy level plus. Please discuss this option with your dancers and bring back their opinion to the next meeting on June 19.

Secretary report: (Andis Garuts) No report.

State Delegates report: (Jim Rogers) (absent) (Mary Schneider presented the report)

At the Mid-Winter Festival, the Federation made \$3,735.63.

2017 Summer Festival: 62 people have signed up for the Capitol tour. On Friday afternoon, dancers will be dancing on the steps of the State Capitol. At the Trails End Dance on Thursday, the callers will be the Wild Cards.

2018 Summer Festival: Everything is coming together slowly. Ribbons have been ordered. Callers and cuers contracts have been signed.

Oregon Federation News: There are 650 addresses on the distribution list for the OFN. Tim thanks the council OFN editors for getting the club information to the OFN in a timely manner.

Parliamentarian: Kathy Roberts, on behalf of Tim, stated that it has been a number of years since the Federation Policies and Procedures have been gone through. Tim will be reviewing them, and the P&P will be reprinted and presented at the State Meeting in September. Total cost: less than \$300.

I put in your boxes the BMI and ASCAP forms. These organizations will be going around and checking whether your callers or cuers have the required licenses for using the soundtracks at the dances. Clubs: it has been suggested that when you make contracts for your callers and cuers, please have them attach copies of their licenses to the contracts. Also, if your club's caller or cuer that is in the building has a valid license, it will cover all of the callers and cuers that are present in the building at the same time that night, even if your visiting callers or cuers do not have valid licenses. Fines for not having a valid license: \$1,500.

At the Youth Scholarship benefit dance, the Federation made \$481.50. Baskets were donated for the raffle. The Youth Committee received youth scholarship applications at this dance, and they are being reviewed.

ORDTA will be visiting the TVC Round Dance Party in July.

State Fair: Marilyn has alerted the Fair that we want to dance there again this year. One day for squares, one day for rounds. She is still waiting for a response from the Fair regarding this.

Background checks: The Federation voted 10 to 2 in favor of setting up a mechanism for doing background checks on callers and cuers at Federated club dances. A flyer with bullet points about what was agreed on regarding this was placed in your folders.

State Directory: Marilyn is working on this. They will be printed in August. Clubs, please update your club information by Summer Festival or sooner.

New Federation Board: Kathy Roberts, President; Lorri McIntosh, Vice President; Tim Hagey, Secretary; Lane Clem, Treasurer; and Patty Cooper, Membership.

There also was a vote on transferring funds from the General Fund to the Youth Scholarship Fund; instead of \$500, it would be up to \$1,000. That way, we can offer two scholarships instead of one.

OROM Rounds of the Month have been distributed.

Our next PAC Meeting is our June Picnic and Meeting, on June 19 at 5:30 p.m. Everyone is welcome. Our new Officers will be installed at this meeting.

The PAC has decided not to participate in this year's Starlight Parade. We will be participating in local parades instead.

OFSRDC Publicity and Education Report: (Kathy Roberts)

The Oregon Federation of Square and Round Dance Clubs Facebook page is up to 293 members. Our Facebook page continues to be an excellent means of advertising dances and special events. Please use it to help promote your clubs' events.

During Summer Festival, we will have a special seminar on how to recognize consumer scams or fraud. The seminar will be presented by JoAnn MacDonald who is the Volunteer Coordinator for the "Consumer Protection", "Financial Fraud" section of the Department of Justice. In addition to presenting her information, JoAnn will be able to answer your questions and concerns.

OFSRDC Youth Report: (Kathy Roberts)

The Federation voted to increase the amount of funds that will be available for Continuing Education Scholarships, effective immediately up to \$1,000 per year. This will allow the Federation to continue awarding up to 2 scholarships per year.
