The Tri-Council dance on March 30 was a fun, well-attended dance. It was also the first TVC dance of the fiscal year for which we did not have a financial loss. There were 108 in attendance, with 93 paying dancers. Net profit was \$281.50. In addition, \$125 in donations for youth dancers collected at the 3/30 dance, and were sent to OFSRDC President, Karyn Buchheit. Thanks to all who donated.

Annual state and TVC dues of \$40 have been received from several clubs – many thanks to the Club Treasurers. Clubs still needing to pay dues by next month are: M'n'Ms, Tri Squares, Valley Squares and Wavesteppers. Checks made out to TVC can be sent to me at 15495 NW Oak Hills Dr., Beaverton, OR 97006.

An annual audit of the TVC books is scheduled in May.

I developed a draft budget for TVC for FY2024-25, and have discussed it with our incoming President. It is in draft form with some changes being made, but will be finalized before being presented in the June TVC meeting.

I spoke to Jeff Knapp, PAC President, about their experience with BottleDrop as a fundraiser. This may be a possibility for TVC if we want to take it on. It has brought in about \$800 a year for the three years PAC has been using it.
