There was an issue with adding Line Dancing to the Federation. Clubs are NOT required to offer line dancing as part of their dances. This simply adds Line Dance clubs to the Federation. Club Secretaries have been sent the ballots out to vote, and the clubs are encouraged to get the ballots back so that they arrive prior to the Summer Festival. So, in order to pass and change the Constitution, 2/3 of the returned ballots must say "yes". The majority voted to add Line Dance clubs to the Federation.

The Beachcombers have roof problems at their hall. The Rogue Sis-Q Council is challenging all other clubs and councils to have benefit dances for the roof at the hall at Port Orford. They'll be having a dance through the sprinklers on Labor Day weekend.

Club Directories and Special Dance/Festival booklets were completed; we were furnished with one booklet per club. Your club should have gotten an e-mail from the Worthingtons about the booklets. It was also noted that many clubs did not respond to the e-mail. One booklet has been placed in each of the club folders in the file box.

Summer Festival: July 19-21 in Salem. As of the Federation Meeting in May, 65 people have registered for the Festival. Please encourage club members to register and participate. Also, in Education, at Summer Festival the Seminar is going to be on How to keep a Club's nonprofit status healthy. The Silver City Squares youth will be running the concession stand as a fundraising activity for the Teen Festival competition.

Insurance: Marilyn Schmit (Insurance Chairman) advises that when a club has a new member, go to the Federation Web site and enter the new member's information and when you save it, it is sent to Marilyn. Once she receives the payment (\$4.75/person), she produces a report to USDA and a new roster is generated and forwarded back to the club. The clubs are encouraged to look over their current certificates of insurance and additional insureds to make sure they are correct.

Scholarships: There were three grants awarded from the Federation to offset costs for Caller/Cuer training. \$500 went to Terry Halley to attend Mike Sikorsky's caller school; \$300 was awarded to Rikki Lobato to attend Circle 8 cuer workshop; and \$500 to Melissa James to attend caller training at Iowa Square Dance Academy.
